
# CALL on Ben & Jerry's on 3/31 (Cesar Chavez day) To Stand up for Farmworker's Rights!

61 fatalities on NY dairy farms from 2006-2014 & farmworker fatalities up 22% in USA from 2014 to 2015



### **DID YOU KNOW?**

THERE ARE APPROXIMATELY 1,200 TO 1,500 MIGRANT FARMWORKERS WORKING ON VERMONT DAIRY FARMS.

THE AVERAGE FARMWORKER WORKS BETWEEN 60 & 80 HOURS EACH WEEK.

I receive less than VT minimum wage
I don't have a day off (ever)

I have been injured or sick due to work
I regularly work 7+ hours without a break to eat
I don't have access to a bathroom or clean water in my workplace
I have been verbally abused by my employer
